Principal Accountabilities

1. Delivers patient care during transportation by following established patient care protocols and procedures, as well as determining and liaison with the appropriate treatment facility to ensure the best possible patient outcome.
2. Performs emergency diagnostic and treatment procedures on-site or during transportation.
3. Coordinate with treatment centre/medical/administrative staff to obtain patient's vital statistics and medical history, to determine circumstances of emergency and to administer emergency treatment.
4. Observe, record and report to Medical Officer/Physician the patient's condition or injury, the treatment provided and reactions to drugs and treatment.
5. Ensure the completion of a daily checklist of ambulance equipment, consumables, sanitary condition and operational readiness of vehicle to respond.
6. Supports Primary Health/Occupational Health nursing activity as directed by Lead Nurse, when not responding to emergency calls.

Decision Making Authority

- Makes complex decisions in medical and traumatic emergencies.
- Prioritize patients in the event of a Mass Casualty Incident (MCI), decides course of care and treatment according to established protocols and policies. Makes decisions on transport destination.
- Correctly identifies and interprets job hazards and risks and ensures appropriate action is taken. Ensures the scene is safe and if not calls appropriate security or fire to ensure a safe scene for ambulance crew and patients.



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Context / Special Features / Challenges

- License to practice as EMT/Nursing to be maintained (**essential**).
- All registration and/or licenses and/or certifications need to remain current and active while under QP Employment (**essential**).
- Sound communication and interpersonal skills (**essential**).
- Valid Qatar driving license (**essential**).
- Valid Emergency Response Vehicle Driving (ERVD) certificate or approved by Medical Officer (EMS) (**essential**).
- Working knowledge of IT systems, i.e. Microsoft word.
- Proficient in written and verbal English (**essential**).
- Maintain accurate manual/computerized patient records and patient confidentiality.
- Uses own professional judgment on problems and emergency situations. Understands when to call for help, i.e. determines patient condition and best course of care according to established protocols and procedures

- Knowledge of radio communications, operations and functionality (**essential**).
- Current Basic Life Support (BLS) (**essential**).
- Current Immediate Life Support (ILS) certification (**essential**).
- Current Advance Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) certification (**preferred**).
- Current International Trauma Life Support (ITLS) certification (**preferred**)
